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We are delighted to welcome the children to Corby Primary Academy at the beginning of their school journey. This is a wonderful time, and we have a lot of new learning planned for your children. This term our topic will be 'Tell Me A Story' focusing on traditional and well-loved stories.

Phonics

Phonics This term we will introduce our phonics scheme Little Wandle programme which will teach your children early reading and spelling. We usually teach four new sounds a week and have a review lesson on a Friday. You will get a list of the sounds that we are learning to have at home. This will help you with pronunciation. Literacy

In Literacy we will be retelling stories using puppets, props and role play as well as creating simple story maps. Towards the end of term, we will be writing simple words. Children will also practise writing their name.


Maths

n reception we use the Mastering Numbers programme. This term children will build on previous experiences of number from their home and nursery environments, and further develop their subitising and counting skills.









This term we will be developing the children's listening skills, through stories, songs and rhymes and be taught the importance of listening in school. The children will be

introduced to lots of new vocabulary in their learning and the school environment. The children will have lots of opportunities to talk and ask questions.

Personal, social and emotional development

The first few weeks, we will introduce the rules and routines of the class and school



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which will be ongoing throughout the term. We will be participating in activities that support children to see themselves as valuable members of Butterflies class. We will be encouraging the children to make new friends and promote positive behaviours such as sharing and turn taking.

Physical development

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We will be developing the children motor skills through movement and drama in our Outside area. We will introduce the children to our writing scheme, Kinetic Letters, which includes animal position to help strengthen children's bodies, to get ready for writing. The children will be supported in managing their own needs such as toileting and handwashing.

Understanding the world

Through various activities the children will be looking at similarities and differences between themselves and their friends.

Understanding the world

In art this term we will be making marvellous marks through drawing. We will be exploring mark making through different drawing materials. We will begin to draw from observation using faces and self-portraits as a stimulus.

Helping your child learn at home

Continue to support your child to be independent, putting on and taking off their coats and shoes.

When your child receives their school reading book please read regularly with them. Support your child in recognising numbers 0-5 then 0-10.


