#### Welcome

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Welcome back I hope you all had a restful break! We are now into our second Autumn term, which will lead us up to Christmas. Our new topic is entitled 'Let's Celebrate', where we will explore Bonfire Night, Remembrance, Birthdays, Weddings and Christmas. Here is what we will be up to...

#### Phonics

Early phonic sessions will take place this term. We will begin by exploring initial sounds. The sounds that we will look at this term are things that begin with s, a, t, i, n and p. Each weekly session will be game based and there will also be an area of the classroom for the children to access independently.

#### Literacy

This term we will be exploring different vocabulary through stories and information texts. We will also be looking at different characters and exploring their feelings and asking questions about various texts.

#### Maths

In Maths we will be continuing to strengthen our subitising skills and will also be counting in a variety of ways. Shape will also be a prevalent concept this term. We will be linking shape early on this term to fireworks and touching upon some 2D shapes and some simple 3D shapes.

#### Communication and language

We will encourage the children to listen and make comments about their learning. Also encourage then to express their ideas and feelings using full understandable sentences. Our new 'Let's Celebrate' topic allows various opportunities for the children to share their own experiences and traditions of various celebrations around this time of year.

Personal, social and emotional development

We will continue to support the children to make positive relationships and help them to settle into new Nursery routines.

## **Physical development**

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We will continue to provide activities to further develop the children's finemotor skills which in turn will help with their letter formation. Support your children to recognise, sort and count numbers confidently 0-5, 0-10.








## **Skills Builder**
