What are we doing to improve?

- ✓ *Further developing support for pupils with specific needs.* At least one staff meeting per half term is designed around supporting children with Special Educational Needs (SEND). Training has not only been conducted by our SENDCO, but also external providers and specialists. Teaching assistants have also undertaken this training.
- ✓ *Increasing parental engagement activities* such as Book and Biscuit Events and Math Problem Solving Mornings. Not only are these great opportunities for parents to support and join in with their child's learning, but it is also an excellent, informal opportunity for teachers to meet with parents.
- ✓ *To share more about how your child is doing,* we are increasing the amount of information and photos uploaded to ClassDojo so that you can discuss the week's learning with your child. In addition to this, we will provide two additional reports during the year (December and April) to update you on your child's progress and attainment. This will be in addition to the end-of-year report and parents' evenings, held twice a year.
- ✓ *Leaders are aiming to be more visible around the school grounds* to connect with parents and carers and model positive behaviours for our pupils. We have instilled 'Wonderful Walking' through the corridors to ensure that transition periods in school are calm and peaceful, whilst the increased visibility of senior leaders before and after school is aimed at ensuring children arrive and leave in a sensible manner.
- ✓ *Increasing the number and breadth of extra-curricular clubs, trips and visitors* by mapping the breadth of experiences across the school. School leaders are currently working on a document that ensures each subject is covered by activities and trips, and that each year group experiences at least two trips or experiences across the year. In addition to this, we are working on ways of increasing the number of sporting activities and competitions our children are exposed to at Corby Primary Academy.

As always, we appreciate your views and welcome visits to the academy at any time if you have a concern or worry that you wish to share.
