Natasha's Law - Allergy Information Required

The UK Food Information Amendment, also known as Natasha's Law, came into effect from October 2021 and requires schools to provide full ingredient lists and allergen labelling on foods pre-packaged for direct consumption on the premises.

The legislation is being introduced to protect allergy sufferers and give them confidence in the food they buy.
