Reading

We will continue to read a range of different texts in our guided reading groups. Please ensure children bring their reading books and records to school every day.

Writing

In the first half of this term, we will be writing a non-chronological report about animals from the Antarctic. In the second half of the term, we will be reading a picture book called 'The Whale' by Ethan and Vita Murrow. In the book two young intrepid explorers set out to find the legendary Great Spotted Whale, they get much more than they bargained for. We will be writing our very own newspaper reports about a legendary creature in the Antarctica!



Geography

Our geography unit this term is all about Antarctica. We will be learning about where Antarctica is on the globe, what type of climate it has and will be looking at its human and physical features. We will also be looking at the journey of Shackleton across the Antarctica.

Maths

This term we will be adding and subtracting fractions and find fractions of different amounts. We will also be looking at money.



Science

We are looking at skeletons and muscles, we will be comparing different skeletons and how it makes each species different. We will also be looking at the diets of different animals looking at carnivores, herbivores, and omnivores.

In PSHE we will be learning how to stay safe by recognising hazards. We will also be looking at recycling and how to look after our environment.

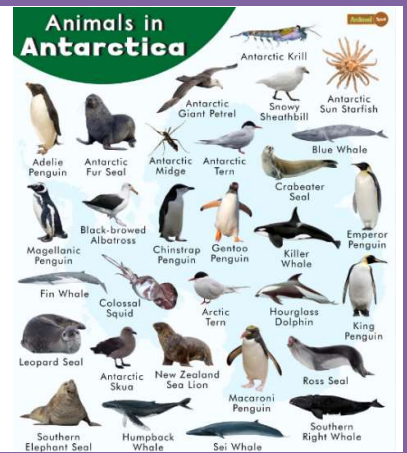




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Homework Project
